CITY OF DYERSBURG

RESIDENTIAL TRASH PICK UP REGULATIONS

The City of Dyersburg provides **free** residential curbside trash pick up to citizens when in compliance with the following regulations.

- 1. **Residential** yard waste only.
- 2. **NO** building material or other waste from remodeling, repair, or any other construction will be picked up.
- 3. Brush, hedges, weeds or branches from tree pruning will be picked up when they comply with the following:
 - (1) Placed on right of way next to the curb.
 - (2) In bundles, boxed, or bagged.
 - (3) Cut to lengths of 5 ft. or less.
 - (4) No appliance boxes.
 - (5) Trash is **NOT** to be placed on sidewalks or in drainage ditches.
- 4. Trees or limbs 12 inches or more in diameter must be **removed** by the individual or property owner.
- 5. Leaves will be removed by vacuum machines during the months of November and December when raked to the street right-of-way. They are **NOT** to be placed on the sidewalk or in a drainage ditch. All other months, trash such as leaves, pine needles, yard rakings **must be** bagged or boxed before they will be removed.

The City of Dyersburg landfill will be open the first Saturday of each month to City residents. Persons outside the **City** and commercial patrons will be charged regular fees.

Civic clubs, neighborhood groups, and other interested parties that want to plan a clean-up day for a certain residential area should call Public Works for assistance in hauling off the refuse.

City of Dyersburg Municipal Code, Title 11, Chapter 8 states that violation of the anti-litter ordinance, including illegal curbside trash, is deemed a misdemeanor and warrants can be issued in accordance with the general penalty clause of this municipal code. It shall be unlawful to place objects or material on a sidewalk or in a drainage ditch, which would limit or interfere with the use, or cause the obstruction of their intended purposes.
